

A Note from Pastor Paul:

When we look at each other and then take an even deeper look within ourselves, what do we see? What does all this look like to our heavenly Father? Jesus' parables have more than one message for us to learn. There is the surface message that we can apply here and now, but then there is the larger message that takes in God's view of heaven and earth, spanning from Genesis to Revelation, including the present "already" and reaching into the future "not yet". To understand it, we must keep Jesus Christ as the central figure. As is the case with the Bible, God, and life, in general, if humanity attempts to leave Christ out, eventually everything will cease to make sense, including his parables.

Matthew 13: 44-46 asks, "How precious is precious?" At what point do you decide that something is worth everything? Have you discovered what is available through Jesus Christ? Are you able to see Christ as a priceless treasure? What would your life look like for you to give up everything for Christ? We can carry these thoughts with us when we approach our Lord's Table to celebrate Communion.

All will be drawn into the net. Matthew 13:47-50 includes souls from every nation, language, culture, and religion. All will be mixed together. Only at the end of the age will there be a separating, the evil from the righteous. How do you know which you are? What is the standard of righteousness? where do we find Christ, as we, the fish, are being "separated'??

Who is prominent in the kingdom of God? Have you realized how valuable you and I are to God? To what lengths will Christ go to find you? What sacrifice will Christ make for you? Jesus gives us the answer in Matthew 18:10-14.

Your question to consider: How much have you and I been forgiven? All of us are actually both servants in the parable. Do you and I like both of these servants? Through Christ, we have been forgiven much, and are called on to forgive one another. How much do we need to forgive each other? Is there anything outside of Christ's forgiveness? Is there anyone whom you or I refuse to forgive? In our world today we need to seriously consider Matthew 18:23-35.

How much do we deserve to receive? Do some deserve more than others? When Christ is the one paying the wages, does he pay fairly? Matthew 20:1-16 wonders what our human nature says in response to this parable.


